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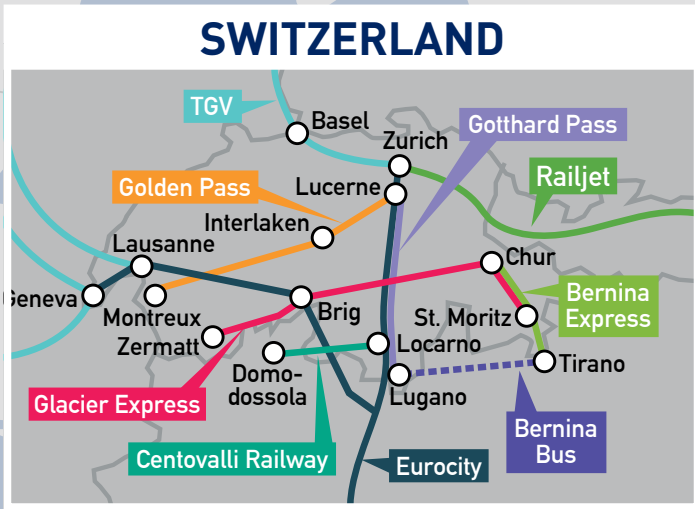

All passenger first and last names, and all dates of birth, are required at the time of booking. Certain train providers will require passport information.

Yes, you can add additional sightseeing activities and/or hotel nights to most existing rail vacation packages we offer. When you speak with a Rail Expert, request an explanation of the upgrade options to your vacation package as you wish. Additional charges may apply.

AM I ABLE TO TRAVEL ON MY CHOICE OF DATES?

There are no set departure dates with our vacations, with the exception of private train journeys such as the Venice Simplon-Orient-Express. Most trains will run every day, which means our vacations do too!

CAN I CHOOSE MY TRAIN TIMES?

Our packages don't have set departure times, and if there is a train running when there are multiple trains a day, your Rail Expert will be able to talk you through the different departures. If there's a particularly convenient time or a departure that will ensure you catch the best scenery, we'll be sure to recommend it.

HOW LONG BEFORE THE TRAIN DEPARTS SHOULD I BE AT THE STATION?

With the exception of Eurostar, which has a 45-minute check-in time, there is no official check-in required for train journeys in Europe or North America. Of course, we always recommend arriving at the station in plenty of time.

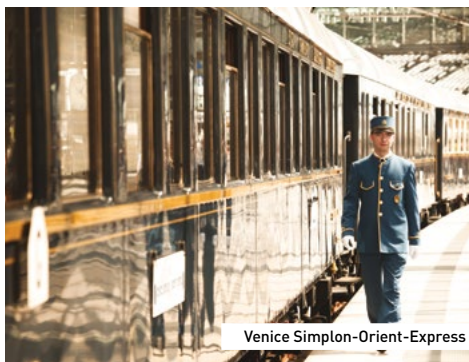

DAY 1: ARRIVAL IN ROME

Arrive in Rome and check into your centrally located hotel for a 3-night stay. Take the remainder of the day to explore the wonders of Rome. Be sure to see the Trevi Fountain illuminated at night—the Baroque architecture is spectacular.

DAY 2: SIGHTS OF ROME

After breakfast, embark on a small group tour of Vatican City, touring St. Peter's Basilica and marveling at Michelangelo's Sistine Chapel. DAY 1: LONDON TO GENEVA

Your journey begins in London, where you'll board the Eurostar to Paris. From there, you'll change trains and continue to Geneva. Upon arrival in Geneva, you'll check into your hotel and then spend some time exploring this cosmopolitan city. Stroll along Lake Geneva, one of Switzerland's most breathtaking lakes. Beside the Jetée des Eaux-Vives, the breakwater enclosing Geneva's harbor, watch the Jet d'Eau shoot a stream of water more than 450 feet into the air. Italy's capital boasts a wealth of history on every street, which you'll be able to explore at your own leisure and during an Imperial Rome tour of the Roman Forum and the Colosseum.

After breakfast this morning, spend the whole day unearthing the ancient and modern wonders of the Italian capital. Discover the city's catholic heritage and Michelangelo's phenomenal ceiling with a skip-the-line tour of the Vatican Museum and Sistine Chapel. 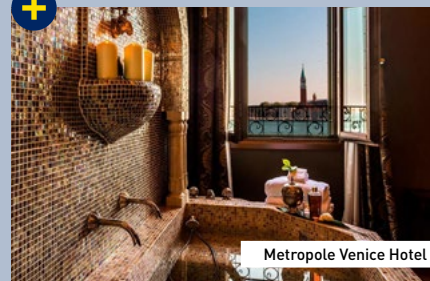

Enjoy a fun cookery lesson in Florence and add a day trip to Tuscany.

DAY 1: MILAN

Arrive in Italy's fashion capital. The day is yours to explore independently, discovering ornate Duomo cathedral, art galleries, quaint cobbled streets, and charming courtyards, picturesque canals and bustling public squares. Overnight hotel included.

DAY 2: MILAN TO LAKE COMO

Catch the train through stunning Lombardy scenery to Lake Como. Surrounded by the snow-capped Rhaetian Alps, dramatic hills and flower-filled orchards, Lake Como will take your breath away with its natural beauty. Overnight hotel gives you time to soak it all up.

DAY 3: LAKE COMO

Admire ornate facades, sip an Aperol Spritz in the Campo Santa Margherita, stroll Rialto markets, and linger among locals in hidden squares. Hop vaporettos to remote islands for new perspectives on this architectural masterpiece.

DAY 7: VENICE TO SESTRI LEVANTE

Wind along the coastline arriving in the idyllic fishing town harbouring crystalline beaches and pastel-hued buildings framing the bay. Relax the afternoon away on soft sands watching yachts drift by before exploring the historic center. Overnight with views overlooking the Mediterranean.

DAY 8: SESTRI LEVANTE

Meander the seaside promenade dotted with cafés, fishing boats, and seafood restaurants. Inhale the fresh air admiring panoramas toward the Cinque Terre. Ascend to higher ground visiting the Gualino Castle ruins and 12th-century church with remarkable mosaic floors. Savor dinner of freshly-caught seafood.

DAY 9: SESTRI LEVANTE

Discover narrow lanes within the historic heart housing quaint squares and fountains. See how time has stood still for centuries within seaside churches. Head to the harbor promenade as the sun sinks into the sea, colors dancing upon calm waters. Reward your explorations with pizza or pasta by the beach.

DAY 10: SESTRI LEVANTE TO FLORENCE

Board morning trains winding through the lush Val di Magra valley past imposing Apuan Alps en route to Pisa. Witness the iconic Leaning Tower before continuing to Renaissance jewel Florence, 'cradle of the Italian Renaissance'. Check into your centrally located hotel, then meander cobbled streets taking in outstanding architecture, landmarks, and charm.

DAY 11: FLORENCE

Embark on a morning tour including the Uffizi Gallery boasting works by Leonardo, Raphael, Michelangelo, and Botticelli. Admire the Duomo's ornate facade and climb to the dome's highest viewpoint for 360° panoramas. Afterwards, wander Piazza della Signoria and vibrant San Lorenzo Market. Dinner overlooking the Arno is the perfect introduction to Tuscan cuisine.

Journey through verdant countryside arriving in ancient Rome, Italy's cosmopolitan capital. Soak up history, culture, and glorious architecture dating back 25 centuries. Check into your centrally located hotel for an initial stroll along Via Condotti and the Spanish Steps before refueling with gelato.

DAY 13: ROME

Freely access all major attractions without queues with your included multi-day tour pass. Marvel at the Colosseum, Baths of Caracalla, and catacombs. Wander forums where Caesar and emperors once held court. Admire Renaissance masterpieces and the Sistine Chapel within atmospheric Vatican City. DAY 1: LONDON

Upon arrival in London, get to know the city during your included hop-on, hop-off River Pass. This is the best way to get an introduction to London as you can see Big Ben, The London Eye, Tower Bridge, and more along the River Thames. 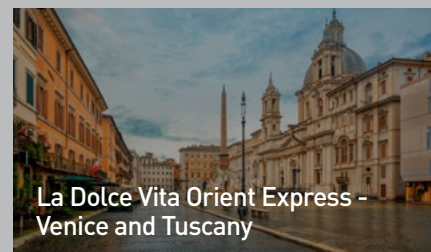
DAY 5: ROME
